HAPPY BIRTHDAY RADIO SAMARITANO

Radio Samaritano celebrated its first anniversary this past September 26th. What a glorious day it was for all of the staff that had been working so hard. That day, prizes were given away to ten of the many people who wrote in wishing us a Happy Birthday. Seven of the winners were from Honduras, two from El Salvador, and one from Nicaragua. The next day the winner from Nicaragua came to receive her prize but that day she also received a greater gift and that is eternal life.

September 26, Cleopatra was cleaning beans in Ocotal Nicaragua. She knew that very soon, she would hear over the radio the winners of the ten prizes. Radio Samaritano had always been a blessing to her life. She was born very poor not having any luxuries of life to be proud of but she knew there was a God in heaven who would take care of her.

One day, she heard over her favorite radio station that their anniversary was coming up and that they would be giving away ten prizes. Three of the prizes were, twenty dollars, sixty dollars, and one hundred dollars in cash. She said "If I could only win twenty dollars it would be such a help for me." That is about how much Cleopatra made in one month.

The day of the drawing, she had her ear to the radio all day long hoping to hear her name. Just before it was about to happen, the lights went out in Ocotal. She could not believe

what was happening. Then she remembered that the Honduras time is one hour behind Nicaragua so it was still early in Honduras. A little later the lights came back on. When the drawing started, her heart was filled with anxiety as all the winners were called out except for the last two. The only two prizes left were, the sixty dollar and the one hundred dollar prize. The announcer called out "the winner of the sixty dollars prize is.....Cleopatra Gomez from Ocotal, Nicaragua." She could not believe that she was going to receive what to her was three months of pay.

That night she could not sleep thinking about how she was going to go to Honduras with out a passport or any money to receive her prize. The next day, she made her way to the border praying that the guards would let her in Honduras. When she arrived, she told them that she had no money and no papers but she had won a prize on Radio Samaritano and she wanted to cross the border to reclaim her prize. Honduras never allows anyone to cross over without papers and money but God had already cleared all the obstacles. She was let in.

She arrived at the studios of Radio Samaritano not knowing what to expect. She introduced herself to our Administrator and very quickly she felt relieved when he said "I am very glad you could make it." The first step was for her to be interviewed over the radio. She set down behind the microphone with one of our announcers telling everyone about what the sixty dollar prize meant to her. But then she said "this will help me for a little while but money cannot solve all my problems or take away my pain." Abetino (our announcer) asked her had she ever been saved. She said no but she knew there was a God who always looked after her because it was because of Him that Radio Samaritano came to her town. The interview was then over.

After a few minutes Abetino witnessed to her about Someone that would give her more than just temporary relief but a joy and peace that is eternal. He spoke to her about Jesus Christ and the love that He showed us by dying on the cross for our sins. She said that she did not know that we

could have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. Abetino asked "Do you want Jesus in your life and in your heart?" She answered, "YES". They both prayed together and she asked Jesus to be her Lord and Saviour. She then asked to be put back on the air because she wanted everyone to know that she had been saved. She then gave her testimony to over five million people over the air. The Bible says that we should not be ashamed of the Gospel of Christ and Cleopatra was definitely not ashamed.

Money , hours of hard work, and prayer were spent, but I feel in my heart that it was all worth it because of **this lady that traveled many miles to claim a gift but left with the greatest gift of all.....SALVATION.**

Christmas Fund 1992

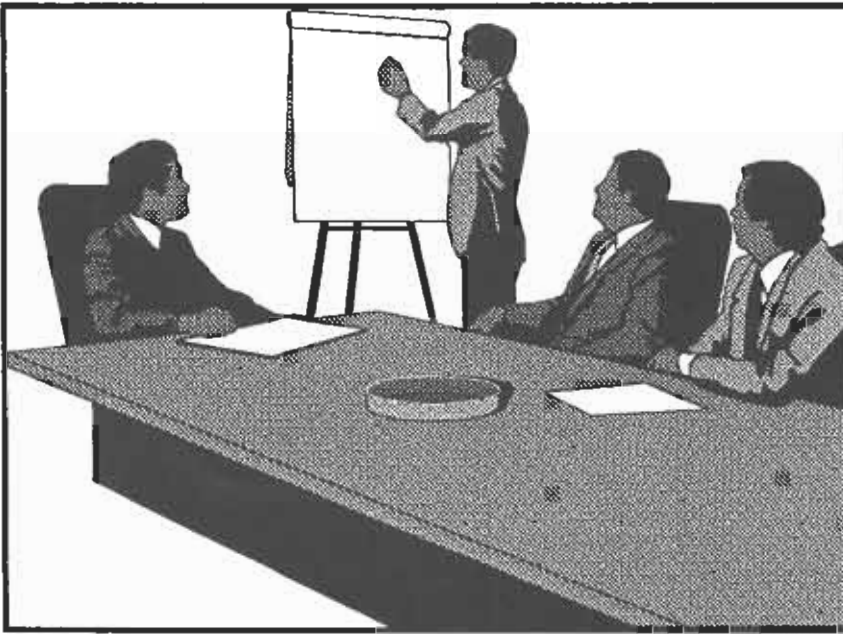

For the past three months, my wife and I have been traveling around the United States promoting the Good Samaritan Mission and the Radio Samaritano. So far we have had over one hundred and twenty children sponsored. Also, we have had forty six hours sponsored for the radio station. We hope to sponsor one hundred hours on the radio before we return to Honduras in December.

In this newsletter, we are promoting the trip to Nicaragua and Honduras in February. This trip will probably change your lives. If you are a pastor, consider making the decision to see with your own eyes what God is doing in another country. We will have to have your deposit by December 1st if you are going.

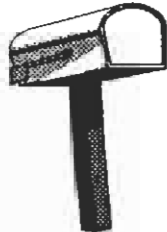

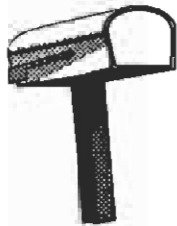

I am a pastor here in this town. What a blessing this station is for me and for my members. Only when we get to heaven, will we find out how many lives your station has touched.

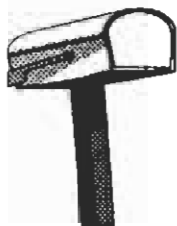

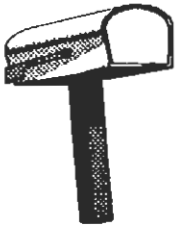
San Lorenzo, Honduras

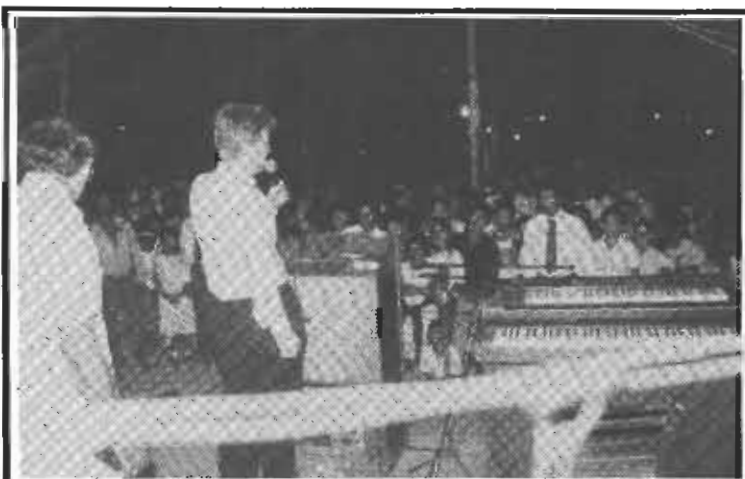


MISSIONS TRIP

NICARAGUA - HONDURAS

1993

Each year, we will be hosting a missions trip to Central America. November of 1991, we traveled with 22 other North Americans to the country of Nicaragua to participate in a crusade in the town of Esteli. That week we had over 200 people saved and a church was started. February 23, we will return to Nicaragua to participate in a evangelistic crusade which will be held in northern Nicaragua. During the day, we will break up into two teams which will enter villages giving out tracts, Bibles and promoting the midday service which all preachers on our trip will have an opportunity to preach the Word. Every night, we will be a part in a large crusade with the purpose of leading hundreds of people to Christ. We will also enter the country of Honduras to visit the radio station and the Christian schools. In Honduras, we will have a one-night Jubilee in the town of San Marcos de Colon which will be a blessing to all of our lives.

SUPPORT A RADIO WORKER

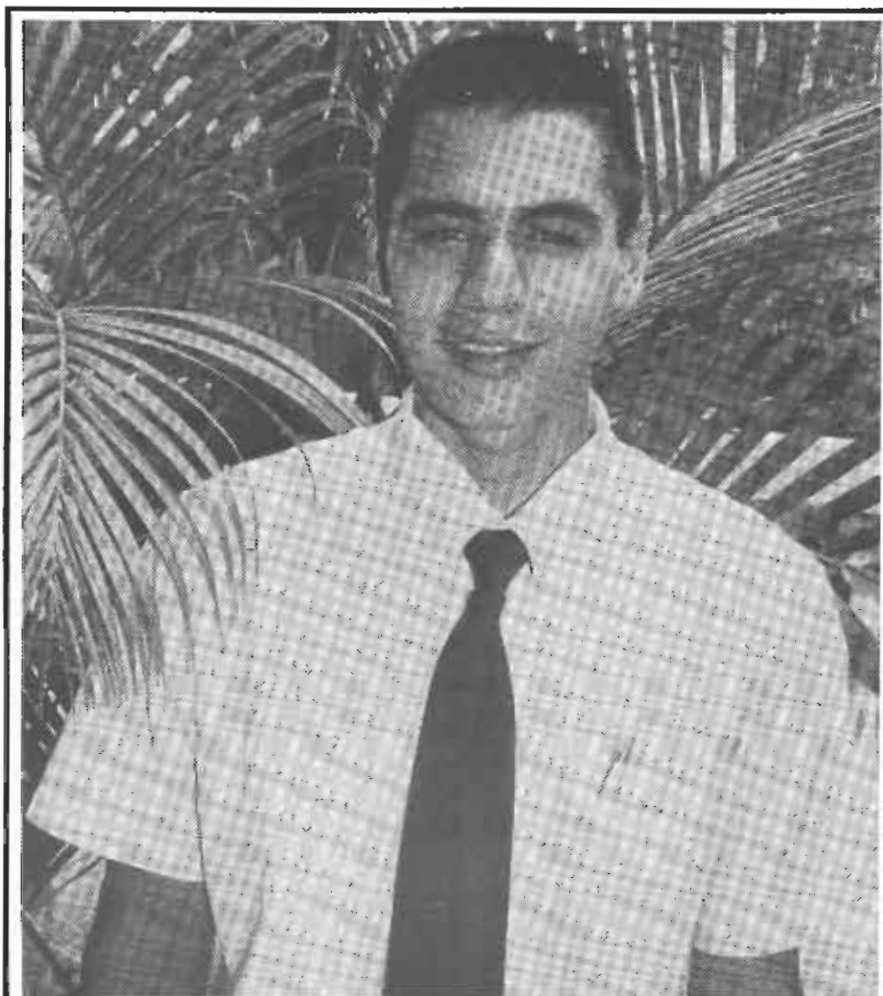

Radio Samaritano would like to give everyone an opportunity to be a part of this life changing ministry. For twenty dollars a month, a family, Sunday school class, or a church can sponsor an hour of Christian broadcasting. Radio Samaritano is now entering three countries and is able to reach more than five million people every day. That averages out to over one million homes. Can you imagine entering one million homes in one hour? Physically it is impossible, but with today's technology, it is being done. It would take thousands of missionaries to preach to that many people but we accomplish that goal every hour of the day. For only twenty dollars a month your family can help spread the Gospel of Christ to spiritually starving people. This is how the program works. When you decide to sponsor an hour, you will receive a certificate for the exact hour each month that you are sponsoring. You will be able to send music, messages, or any other type of Christian programming; and even if you have nothing to send, we have many trained, national pastors who can preach during your hour. The message will still get out. **The important thing is that your family will have an hour each month to get together and pray, that the message being preached on Radio Samaritano will convict the lost.** There is not a radio station in America on which you can preach to five million people for twenty dollars. Radio Samaritano now has the equipment, the personnel, preachers, and the listening audience but we need you to help us fund this ministry. Sponsoring an hour will help us grow until one day all of Central America will know about God's love.

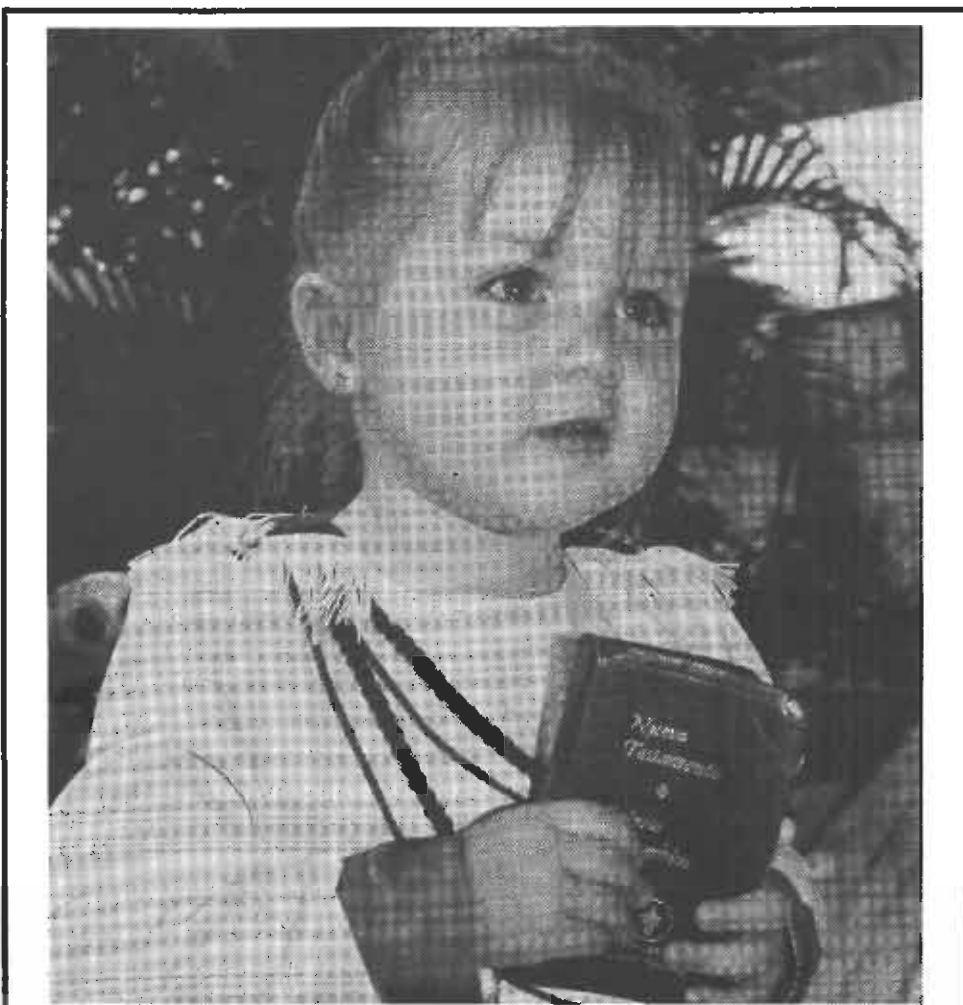


ONE OF THE STUDIOS AT RADIO SAMARITANO
